Lasting Impacts: Eli's Story

As a young mother of her first child, Ashley could not wait to hold her baby and create a bond that would last a lifetime. Ashley had a typical pregnancy and gave birth to a healthy baby boy. Soon after, Ashley encountered postpartum depression. She had a desire, as any new mother, to bond with her dark-haired, hazel-eyed baby boy...but that was not happening naturally. Many things from this point were unfamiliar territory for Ashley, as baby Eli was a challenging infant. He did not enjoy being held and cuddled, and seemed detached from his parents. Going out of the house was no easy task as he was difficult to soothe or satisfy.

When Eli began to walk, he walked on his tiptoes and could not walk flat-footed. Also as a toddler, Eli made no babbling sounds and did not know how to communicate his wants and needs. Ashley knew this was a concern and Eli's pediatrician referred him for further testing. Ashley soon learned at 18 months old that Eli had Autism.

Luckily, the family soon found out about Achievement Academy, a special place where knowledgeable staff could help their precious little boy. Eli enrolled in August of 2017 and began receiving specialized instruction, physical, occupational and speech therapy...all in a collaborative setting.



After only seven months enrolled in Achievement Academy's charter school, Eli made huge developmental gains. He began to interact with his parents and has bonded beautifully with his mom and dad. He went from drinking from a bottle to a cup and began trying to use a spoon to feed himself. Eli learned to communicate several words that his parents could understand, which helped to ease frustrations. He now walks flat-footed, can walk up and down stairs and can jump appropriately.

Eli has made significant gains over the past year. He recently graduated from physical therapy and is now on track with his gross motor skills. Eli can communicate with four to five-word sentences and has a great bond with his one-year-old brother.

"Not only has Achievement Academy helped our son and family, but his grandparents as well." stated Ashley. "Eli's grandfather has picked him up from school and learned from staff and other parents, that it is okay if your child or grandchild has a different ability and that they are not alone. The Achievement Academy has given our family help, hope and without it we would not have made it this far."
