The Achievement Academy, formerly Child Development Center of Polk County, Inc. offers the gift of hope to children with special needs and their families. In 1955, a group of visionary parents needed special place to help their children succeed and that is how the journey first began.



Since that time, Achievement Academy has remained committed to creating brighter futures for children with developmental delays by providing early intervention through: Support, Therapy, Education, Advocacy and Resources. Exciting news came this year when our Charter School contract was approved through 2022.

Our Charter School Program provides innovative Pre-Kindergarten instruction for children with special needs ages eighteen months through six years of age. Currently enrollment is limited to the 89 children attending classes at three locations in Polk County. There are over 58 children on the waiting list for enrollment and the number continues to grow each day. This is a sobering statistic that creates a sense of urgency to expand our services to more children and


