Bathrooms do not have stall doors but do have partitions and are used by two students at a time, so it is unclear whether they would be approved for use considering that the school is exclusively special needs students. Will refer to Tallahassee for guidance on this subject and will update the facility on requirements.

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Violations Comments

Violation #5. Maintenance & Repair
Water damage observed in hallway ceiling tiles. Some ceiling tiles around the facility are damaged. These tiles should be replaced. There is a broken light cover that has also been displaced from the ceiling. Replace light cover and insure it is secure in the ceiling.
CODE REFERENCE: Maintenance & Repair. 6A-2.0040(3)(b)(c). Buildings shall be kept clean & in good repair, free from hazardous conditions, such as loose or broken floor tiles & boards; loose moldings; loose hanging fixtures, pipes, electric wires; & broken plaster. Furnishings & equipment shall be kept clean & in good repair, free of missing parts & sharp edges.

Violation #21. Solid Waste
Dumpster has holes in the bottom resulting from rust and corrosion. It should either be repaired or replaced by trash collection company.
CODE REFERENCE: Solid Waste. 6A-2.0040(9). Garbage, trash, & rubbish shall be collected, stored, & disposed of at a frequency & in a manner that prevents a sanitary nuisance. Wet garbage shall be collected & stored in impermeable, leak proof, fly tight containers pending disposal. Outdoor waste containers must be easily cleanable & serviceable. Waste containers & the storage area shall be cleaned frequently to prevent odors & breeding places for vermin. 468.2.3. A smooth nonabsorbent surface shall be provided for outdoor waste containers.
